

10 WINTER CHECKS FOR YOUR CAR

- Check your tyres including side walls and valves, the legal depth is 1.6mm and 3mm minimum is recommended in bad weather conditions.
- Check your antifreeze strength: cooling system failure is a leading cause of engine related breakdowns.
- Check your windscreen wipers are not split and clear the screen - replace if necessary.
- Check that your windscreen cleaning fluid is kept topped up with anti freezing solution.
- Check your battery connections are tight and the fluid level is correct. Have the battery checked if the engine is slow turning over.
- Check your brake fluid level is ok.
- Check your heated rear window and heated windscreen (if fitted) is operational.
- Check the operation of your lights and carry spare bulbs in your car.
- Check the operation of your climate control: when operating correctly and the recirculation button is selected, the car will demist and remove moisture much faster.
- Consider having your car professionally waxed: this will help protect the paint against road salts and bad weather and make the snow slip off the car easily.

- 1 Check for damage to bodywork and trims.
- 2 Check operation of airbag warning lights.
- 3 Check condition and operation of safety belts.
- 4 Check operation of interior and exterior lights.
- 5 Check operation of ABS warning lights.
- 6 Check windscreen washers, wipers and fluid.
- 7 Check internal electrics and safety systems.
- 8 Check operation of suspension dampers.
- 9 Check under bonnet for fluid leaks.
- 10 Check and record brake fluid condition.
- 11 Check power steering operation/fluid condition.
- 12 Check battery condition, level and terminals.
- 13 Check condition of all drive belts.
- 14 Check under bonnet fluid levels.
- 15 Check and record anti-freeze strength
- 16 Carry out tyre report.
